SIR STATE BOWLING COMMITTEE MEETING Minutes of meeting held on February 22, 2020

Location: Fireside Lanes - Conference Room

Chairman SIR Russ Salazar called the meeting to order at 10:20 AM.

I. Opening – SIR Russ Salazar

1. SIR Salazar convened the meeting at 10:20 AM with the Pledge of Allegiance.

II. Introductions: All attendees were asked to introduce themselves and to sign the Meeting Attendance Sheet (see Exhibit 1).

III. Review of Meeting Agenda– SIR Russ Salazar

1. SIR Salazar reviewed the meeting agenda (see Exhibit 2). A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the agenda as presented.

IV. Minutes of Previous Meeting - SIR Gary Kaufmann

1. SIR Kaufmann read the minutes of the previous SIR State Bowling Committee Meeting, conducted on September 17, 2019 (see Exhibit 3). SIR Kaufmann asked those in attendance for any comments, additions, or revisions. No comments, additions, or revisions were proposed. A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the September 17, 2019 minutes as read.

V. Treasurer's Report - SIR Larry Mustain

1. **2019 Annual Financial Report:** SIR Mustain presented the 2019 Annual Financial Report (see Exhibit 4).

The beginning balance for 2019 was \$5,812.84. Additional income for 2019 was \$1,514.12 Ten-Pin Assessment money of \$1,513.60, plus checking account interest of \$0.52. Therefore, the total incoming assets for 2019 were \$7,326.96

Expenses for 2019 were \$811.44 (\$120.00 for meetings, \$559.50 for tournament awards, and \$131.94 for miscellaneous expenses).

Ending Balance as of December 31, 2019 was \$6,515.52. The net gain for 2019 was \$702.68 (\$6,515.52 - \$5,812.84).

SIR Mustain noted that the SIR State Bowling Committee checking account was with U.S. Bank in Pollock Pines until August 8, 2019 when the bank gave notice it was closing the branch.

A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the 2019 Annual Financial Reports as presented.

2. **Proposed 2020 Budget:** SIR Mustain presented the Proposed 2020 Budget (see Exhibit 5).

Estimated income for 2020 is \$1,280 for 10-Pin Assessments.

Estimated expenses for 2020 are \$1,850.00 (\$350.00 for meeting expenses, \$325.00 for tournament software, \$350.00 for tournament awards, \$500.00 for SIR State Tournament prize fund contribution, and miscellaneous expenses of \$150.00).

SIR Mustain noted that the \$325.00 for tournament software is a one-time expenditure. However, future upgrades to the tournament software are estimated to be \$50.00 every two (2) years. The \$500.00 annual contribution to the SIR State Tournament prize fund is expected to continue in subsequent budget years.

A motion was made, seconded, and approved to accept the Proposed 2020 Budget as presented.

3. **10-Pin Assessment Amount:** Tournament participation in 2019 was down 10% from 2018. There was some discussion whether the 10-Pin Assessment amount of \$0.40 should be increased for 2020. SIR Mustain proposed we keep the 10-Pin Assessment amount at \$0.40, continue to try and increase attendance at tournaments, and review the 10-Pin Assessment amount at the end of 2020.
4. **SIR Tournament Financial Reports:** SIR Mustain reminded all Tournament Managers to use the approved SIR Tournament Financial Report Form available on the SIR State Bowling Website.

VI. Review of 2018 - 2019 Tournament Results - SIR Ray DiBasilio

1. SIR DiBasilio stated that in some cases SIR tournament results are being submitted in the form of a picture (jpeg file). The preferred format for tournament results is an Excel file. Tournament results provided in an Excel file makes it easier for SIRs Dan Weller and Art Tourtillott to maintain the SIR Bowling Tournament Averages Database. Tournament results in a PDF file are acceptable, but less desirable.

Tournament Results for each event shall have the following information:

Event and Division;

The average designation for the Division (e.g. 179 and above, 178 or under);

Place rankings for the event;

Bowler's name;

Branch (add G to Branch number, if guest);

USBC ID number;

Average;

Score for each game;

Scratch total for event;

Total handicap for event;

Total including handicap for the event; and

Prize money awarded.

2. SIR DiBasilio stated that he can provide assistance to Tournament Managers, as necessary. Tournament Managers requiring assistance shall contact SIR DiBasilio as early as possible prior to the tournament date.

VII. 2020 SIR Bowling Tournament Schedule – SIR Ray DiBasilio

1. SIR DiBasilio reviewed the 2020 SIR Bowling Tournament Schedule (see Exhibit 6). The Granada Bowl tournament on February 12, 2020 was cancelled. Jack Evans will be the Tournament Manager for the Paddock Bowl tournament on May 28th and 29th. The SIR State Bowling Tournament originally scheduled for May 13th and 14th at McHenry Bowl in Modesto has been rescheduled to take place on November 5th and 6th. The SIR State Bowling Tournament will replace the regular SIR Bowling Tournament originally scheduled on November 5th and 6th at McHenry Bowl.

VIII. Declining Participation in 2019 SIR Bowling Tournaments – SIR Ray DiBasilio

1. SIR DiBasilio presented 2018 - 2019 Bowling Tournament Player Statistics (see Exhibit 7). Bowler participation in 2019 SIR bowling tournament was down 9.5% from 2018. Tournaments with the largest percentage decline from 2018 to 2019 were Stockton (39.7%), Livermore (34.5%), Paradise (100%, cancellation due to fire), Brentwood (20.9%), and Danville (36.2%).
2. The following ideas for improving tournament participation were discussed:
 - a) Weekend tournaments (less traffic and conflicts with weekday senior leagues);
 - b) Have more 2-day tournaments which would allow for more options for when events are bowled and how participants can plan their travel and lodging;
 - c) Notification of tournaments via e-mail and SIR Branch Newsletters;
 - d) The Reno/Carson City tournament lists or SIR Constant Contact list could be used to invite tournament participants. The Reno Carson City list is the most complete for SIR bowlers. The SIR Constant Contact list includes all members of SIR that have provided an email;
 - e) Add another tournament in the Sacramento area. Sacramento has a large number of SIR bowlers that could participate in a local tournament;
 - f) Offering both handicap and scratch brackets at more tournaments. Many bowlers enjoy entering brackets and competing for cash prizes. Tournament Managers in attendance indicated they would like to offer brackets but lacked the software and manpower to run them efficiently. The SIR Bowling Committee may be able to provide some assistance by providing access to the BTM software; and
 - g) Standardization of handicap basis for tournaments (100% of 230).

IX. SIR Bowling Leagues – SIR Russ Salazar

1. SIR Salazar presented a review of official and unofficial SIR-sponsored bowling leagues (see Exhibit 8). The majority of the SIR leagues identified allow non-SIR male guests to participate in order to meet minimum house requirements. In the summer of 2019 the State SIR Insurance Committee informed the SIR State Bowling Committee that leagues allowing non-SIR guests were violating SIR State maximum guest participation requirements and therefore were not cover by SIR's insurance provider. For the 2019-2020 winter bowling season, most SIR leagues operated informally without formal SIR Branch sponsorship.
2. At the October 2019 SIR State Board Meeting the Bowling Committee requested the a waiver of the SIR membership requirement for a period of five (5) years in order to study the effectiveness of bowling as a membership recruiting tool. The SIR State Board granted a 3-year waiver. During the 3-year waiver period SIR members are encouraged to recruit non-SIR league members to join SIR and track membership increases.
3. The 3-year SIR membership waiver for guest participation does not extend to SIR bowling tournaments. Non-SIR guests would be limited to participating in 3-5 SIR events (lifetime) as a guest prior to joining SIR.

X. SIR Bowling Bylaws, Rules, and Guidelines Update – SIR Russ Salazar

1. SIR Salazar requested two or three 3 SIR Tournament Managers volunteer to participate in updating the SIR Bowling Bylaws, Rules and Guidelines. SIR Ron Johnson and SIR John Fry volunteered to help.

XI. SIR Tournament Expenses – SIR Russ Salazar

1. SIR Salazar clarified that copying, postage, and meeting attendance mileage related to operation of a SIR Tournament may be paid for out of the tournament expenses. Mileage will be reimbursed at 35 cents/mile.

XII. SIR Tournament Entry Applications and Results Reporting – SIR Dan Weller

1. SIR Weller conducted a PowerPoint Presentation on Tournament Applications and Results Reporting Usage.

2. The following topics were presented by SIR Weller (for details of these topics see Exhibit 9):

- a) Tournament Computer Data Entry Applications;
- b) Application Templates;
- c) Tournament Results Usage;
- d) SIR Bowling Averages; and
- e) SIR Bowling Tournament Website.

XIII. Open SIR Bowling Committee Positions – Russ Salazar

1. Russ Salazar stated the following two (2) SIR State Bowling Committee positions are open:

- a) Assistant Treasurer; and
- b) Assistant Secretary.

SIR STATE BOWLING COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES SEPTEMBER 17, 2019 STEVE COOK'S FIRESIDE LANES CITRUS HEIGHTS, CA

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Sir Russ Salazar with the Pledge of Allegiance. The agenda (Exhibit A) was approved as presented. The State-approved anti-discrimination policy was distributed (Exhibit B) and discussed. It was recommended that the policy be referenced on all entry applications for future Sir-sponsored tournaments. Tournament Managers (TMs) will have the option to determine how to reference it. Most importantly, all TMs should follow the detailed process for handling any future discrimination complaints they may receive pertaining to their Sir-sponsored tournaments.

In the past, SIR members achieving scores of 298, 299, or 300 in SIR-sponsored tournaments have been awarded a watch with the SIR logo and score achieved. However, we have no watches left and the manufacturer has gone out of business. Sir Russ has researched alternative awards and has found custom rings with the SIR logo. The watches will be replaced with a Sir ring and an appropriately inscribed plaque.

Sir Russ, Acting Treasurer, (the Treasurer's position is currently vacant) presented the August 7, 2019 Financial Statement (Exhibit C) which shows a balance of \$6,348.93. This balance was transferred to the Pollock Pines branch of El Dorado Savings Bank on August 8, 2019 due to the closing of the Pollock Pines branch of U.S. Bank where the account had previously been. The current pin assessment was discussed. It was decided to continue the assessment of \$.40 per event.

Sir Ray DiBasilio, Operations Advisor, presented to the Committee and TMs the proposed 2020 SIR Bowling Tournament Schedule (Exhibit D). The proposed schedule was approved by the Committee/TMs as presented. Chairman Russ will then present the Committee/TM-approved schedule to the SIR State Board for final approval at their October 19 meeting.

Sir Ray then reviewed the Tournament Timeline and Checklist through a PowerPoint presentation. Sir Ray explained, in detail, the most important points. He emphasized that verification of current USBC membership on Bowl.com is the most important point. If not found on Bowl.com, and a current USBC membership card is not available, receipt of payment of dues or a letter from the Area or League Secretary will suffice.

Sir Russ presented the new SIR logo and emblem (Exhibit E). As shown, the new logo shows a more prominent running rooster with the banner line "Social Activities for Men". The new emblem is the same image we've had in the past; however, the old banner line "Sons in Retirement" is replaced with "Activities for Men". A show of hands favored the new emblem over the new logo.

Sir Dan Weller made a presentation regarding the SIR Bowling Tournament Average. SBTA options were discussed varying the time period and number of games required to establish an SBTA average. Following discussion of various options it was determined that the current system not be changed.

After lunch, Sir Craig Hoffhines, Chairman of the SIR Insurance Committee, was introduced to give the Committee and TMs an update on insurance for non-member male guests. There has been a question of liability insurance for guests at SIR events such as SIR-sponsored bowling tournaments. Craig stated that the question was finally answered on Sept 15th by letter from the SIR state insurance carrier. All SIR members and associates (guests) are covered by the policy. The insurance company should be notified of functions anticipating more than 500 participants.

The SIR State Board has a rule that limits male guests to participation in no more than three SIR functions or they must become members to continue their participation. There are SIR bowling leagues where all participants are not members. We think SIR branch-sponsored leagues have been an effective membership recruiting tool however not all male guests join SIR but they continue their required participation for the term of the summer or winter league. Their continued participation, 16-35 league bowling days, violates the State participation rule. Sir Russ will be requesting that the SIR State Board, at their October 19th meeting, grant an exemption from this rule for SIR branch-sponsored bowling leagues until a solution can be found. The proposed exemption will last up to five years beginning January 1, 2020.

Guidelines and bylaw changes to be reviewed.

1. General TM meetings should be sometime in February and August. Meetings should be held at bowling centers which will save money. Saturday meetings (to reduce driving times) to be considered.
2. Clarify multiple participation in Tournament Guidelines. Can participants collect prize money if they bowl and place in multiple double and team events. If so, explain.
3. A new financial report form for tournaments (Exhibit F) is on the web site. A copy of the lineage receipt should be included with the report.

After some discussion a motion was passed to add \$500 from Committee funds to the Annual State Tournament team event, evenly divided between Divisions A and B and distributed per guideline policy

Rule 18 (Exhibit G) was reviewed by Ray DiBasilio. The surface of the bowling ball shall not be altered or cleaned with any substance during competition. A ball cannot have any substance like powder or resin on it.

In closing Sir Russ noted that there are several vacant positions on the Committee and invited anyone interested in serving to contact him.

EXHIBIT B

Policy 1. GUIDING PRINCIPLES

1. SIR Mission- The guiding principles of our Bylaws, Policies and Procedures shall be governed by the Mission of SIR and applied with common sense. The Mission of SIR is to enhance the lives of our members through fun activities and events while making friends for life.

2. Non-Discrimination Principle - SIR policies, procedures, bylaws, and supporting practices are built upon the principle that trust, mutual respect, and dignity are fundamental beliefs between all members of our organization. SIR does not and shall not discriminate against any member, guest, or prospective member of our organization on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, marital status, sexual orientation, age or disability. SIR shall comply with all applicable national, state and local statutes pertaining to nondiscrimination. In furtherance of these commitments, it has and will continue to be a fundamental policy to update and take action-oriented steps to implement our policy. (See Procedure 1, How to Respond to Individual Complaints.)

Procedure 1- How to Respond to Individual Complaints

The procedure for responding to individual complaints shall be as follows:

1. Any member or prospective member who believes that inappropriate discrimination has occurred shall notify the branch's Big Sir within a reasonable time following the alleged discriminatory action.
2. The Big Sir shall immediately notify the Area Governor, Regional Director, and Vice President; hereinafter referred to as the Discrimination Task Force (DTF).
3. The Big Sir concurrently shall commence a thorough investigation and report, within thirty days from the notice of the alleged discrimination, all information about the complaint to the DTF.
4. The DTF shall take appropriate action to address the complaint, including meeting with the complainant and any other parties that may be relevant, and within a reasonable time thereafter issue its recommendations to the State Board.
5. The State Board at a special meeting or its next scheduled Board meeting shall review the complaint and the DTF recommendations, and approve appropriate action to resolve the complaint. This action shall be communicated to all involved parties.

EXHIBIT G

Rule 18 – Bowling Ball - Altering Surface rules change effective August 1, 2019

A change to Rule 18 eliminates the use of any products on a bowling ball once competition has started, takes effect August 1, 2019. This includes powder, patting rosin bags on the ball, and cleaners formerly listed as approved for competition. Should a ball come back with surface residue that cannot be removed with a dry towel/cloth, bowlers must seek permission from a league or tournament official to use a product allowed to clean the ball.

Rule 18 – Bowling Ball - Altering Surface

While bowling in USBC competition, a bowling ball cannot:

- a. Have the surface altered by the use of an abrasive.
- b. Be cleaned with any liquid substance or cleaning agent.
- c. Have any foreign material on it including, but not limited to, powder, rosin, marker or paint.

All bowling balls so altered or cleaned must be removed from the competition.

Note: Should a foreign substance appear on the outer surface of a bowling ball which cannot be removed with a dry towel, an approved cleaner may be used with consent from a league or tournament officer.

Commonly Asked Questions – Rule 18

- 18/1 When may I alter the surface of my bowling ball?
You are permitted to sand, polish, or clean the surface of your bowling ball prior to the start of competition. However, once tournament or league play begins, altering the surface of a bowling ball is strictly prohibited. This includes balls that have not yet been introduced into play.
- 18/2 A tournament consist of doubles and singles events. The singles event is bowled first immediately followed by the doubles. Can I "alter the surface of" my bowling ball between events?
No. Rule 18 does not allow the outer surface of any bowling ball to be altered after the start of competition. Since the tournament is conducting singles and doubles concurrently, you cannot alter the surface of the bowling ball between events.
- 18/3 Can a bowler use an abrasive, cleaner or polish on just the track or only just a portion of the track of the ball?
No. USBC specifications require that the entire surface of the ball be prepared in a uniform manner. Preparing the surface of a ball in any other manner would be a violation of Rule 17a, Item 1. The penalty for a violation of this rule can include disqualification, forfeiture, removal from the league, and/or suspension of USBC membership.

SIR-SPONSORED BOWLING LEAGUES

In 2018 we identified about 20 official and unofficial SIR-sponsored bowling leagues almost all those leagues allowed non-SIR male guests to participate in order to meet minimum house requirements. The State SIR Insurance Committee informed us that those leagues were violating State maximum male guest participation requirements and therefore were not covered by SIR insurance. The Bowling Committee requested that the SIR State Board waive the rule for League bowlers for five years in order to study the effectiveness of league bowling as a membership recruiting tool. The SIR State Board granted a three year waiver. In 2019 most leagues operated informally without formal SIR Branch sponsorship. In September 2019 the Committee learned that ALL guests were indeed insured. The Committee requests input from TMs as to how to proceed from this point.

DECLINING BOWLING LEAGUE/TOURNAMENT PARTICIPATION

1. In 2018 there were 1,753 participants in eighteen SIR-sponsored bowling tournaments. In 2019 there were 1,587 participants in eighteen SIR tournaments – a decline of about 9.5%. This decline seems to be the general average of the decline in physical participation found in other organizations that are similar to SIR. As yet no clear cause has been identified. The SIR Bowling Committee is considering two possible causes – poor publicity and heavy weekday commute traffic.
 - A. Eighteen SIR bowling tournaments are conducted throughout the year all over Central/Northern California and Nevada. To date publicizing the tournaments has been mainly local word-of-mouth. A wider target area would probably help to reach SIR bowlers that may not be aware of the tournament dates and locations. The Committee is studying the Constant Contact program to possibly use it to help reach a broader audience.
 - B. Many participants complain of having to drive as much as 3-4 hours morning and evening, hitting peak commuter traffic each way and still bowling six games in between. The Committee will encourage Tournament Managers to schedule 2020 tournaments on weekends when there is less traffic.
2. We lost one tournament and gained one tournament during each of the years 2018 and 2019 so the total number of tournaments remained unchanged. However, in only the second month of 2020 we've been

notified that two, possibly three tournaments will be discontinued. The SIR Bowling Committee's current priority is the recruitment of new tournament sponsors to replace the discontinued tournaments. The Committee offers a comprehensive hands-on training program for SIR branches willing to sponsor a tournament. We are researching different ways to communicate directly with all the branches to glean potential sponsors. Again, we think the Constant Contact program will help so we intend to probably use it.

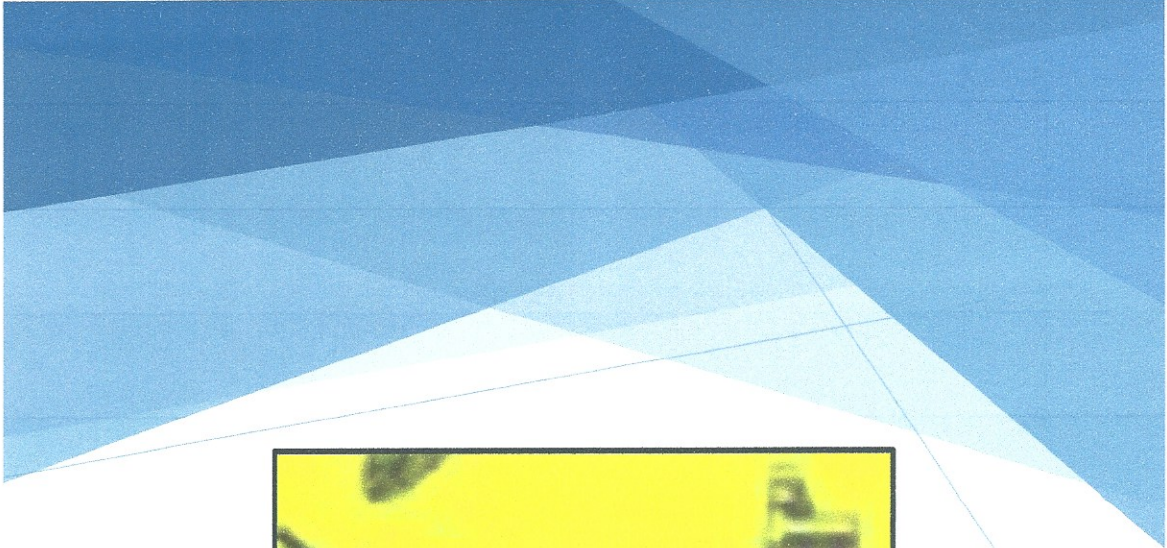

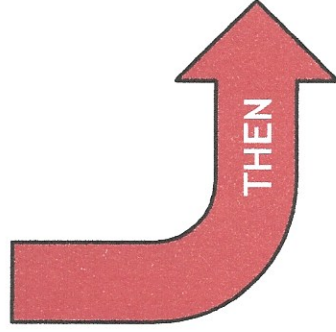

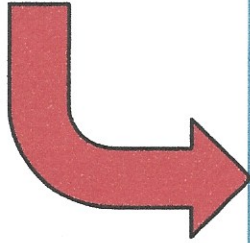

If We Have Time ...

SBTA Topics:

- You may have noticed that we only store the event scores, not each game.
- This is an issue when a bowler only does 1 or 2 games in an event. We still use the total score as 3 games. This reduces his / her average.
- We store all events that a bowler does. This includes multiple Doubles and Team participation. So, a bowler could do 4 or 5 or 6 events in a single tournament. In this case, we will count 12, 15, or 18 games for a single tournament.

Archived Data:

- We store all Applications and Results Reports on our website. Data goes back to 2015.
